Project CHILD FIND

Project CHILD FIND is a free referral service and public awareness campaign to assist in the identification of unserved or underserved youths ages 3-21 who may be disabled. Preschoolers who demonstrate delays in the development of motor, communication, social-emotional or cognitive skills may be eligible for special education and/or related services. School-age students between the ages of 5 and 21 who may be disabled due to physical, sensory, educational, communication, cognitive or social difficulties may also be eligible for special education and related services. If your child appears to have one or more of the following signs, please contact the Harrison Public Schools Department of Special Services:

- Significant delays in acquiring language or significant speech problems
- Significant difficulty walking, running, or manipulating small objects
- Frequent health problems or disabilities present from birth
- Consistent trouble seeing or hearing
- Tendency toward temper tantrums or excessive anxiety/shyness
- Significant difficulty playing appropriately with other children
- Significant problems paying attention and listening

New Jersey's Early Intervention System provides services for infants and toddlers (from birth to the child's third birthday) who have developmental delays or disabilities, as well as support for the families. Parents who have questions may call 1-800-322-8174.

For children 3-21 years of age, the Harrison school district provides free appropriate public education (FAPE) for eligible students. Parents who have questions about the eligibility of their child are encouraged to contact the Harrison Public Schools Department of Special Services by located at 1 North 5th Street Harrison, New Jersey 07029, 973-483-2128, Ext. 5032. Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a new school year. We hope it will be full of new and wonderful experiences for your child.

The purpose of this note is to inform parents that we will be conducting a brief developmental screening for any child who is <u>new</u> to our program this year. This would include all three yearolds and any four year-olds just beginning pre-school with us. The screening is completed on an individual basis by the child's teacher. It only takes ten to fifteen minutes to complete and assesses each child's performance in several developmental areas. It is not a testing instrument, but is instead conducted by having the children play a few fun games with the classroom teacher. The results of this screening will be used to tailor each child's educational and developmental program for the current school year.

If your child completes this screening as a result of being new to our program, you will be notified. You may in turn request a meeting with your child's teacher to discuss the results.

We hope that you and your child have a very happy and successful preschool experience. Should you have any questions regarding the above, please feel free to contact me or any Early Childhood staff member and we will be happy to address them.
